04. First-aid measures

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After inhalation

Take the casualty into the fresh air and keep warm. Keep at rest. Irregular breathing/no breathing: artificial respiration.
Unconsciousness: lateral position - call a physician.

After skin contact

Immediately remove all contaminated clothing. Wash away with soap and water and rinse. Do NOT use solvents or thinners.

After eye contact

Remove contact lenses, keep eyelids open. Flush with plenty of water (10 - 15 min.). Call a physician.

After ingestion

Contact a doctor immediately. Keep at rest. Do not induce vomiting.

05. Fire-fighting measures

Suitable extinguishing media

Alcohol resistant foam, CO₂, powders, water spray.

Unsuitable extinguishing media

Waterjet.

Special risk posed by the substance or by the actual preparation, its combustion products or gases discharged

Fire will produce dense black smoke. Exposure to decomposition products may cause a health hazard.

Special protective equipment

Appropriate breathing apparatus may be required.

Additional information

Cool endangered containers with water in case of fire. Do not allow the quenching water into the sewage system.

06. Accidental release measures

Personal precautions

Provide for sufficient ventilation. Do not inhale the vapour. Refer to protective measures listed in sections 7 and 8.

Environmental precautions

Do not empty into drains. If the product contaminates lakes, rivers or sewages, inform appropriate authorities in accordance with local regulations.

Methods for cleaning up/collecting

Contain and collect spillage with non-combustible absorbent materials, e.g. sand, earth, vermiculite, diatomaceous earth and place in container for disposal according to local regulations (see section 13). Clean preferably with a detergent; avoid use of solvents.

07. Handling and storage

Information for safe handling

Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Do not inhale the vapour. Do not eat or drink during work - no smoking. Comply with the health and safety at work laws.

Requirements to be met by storerooms and containers

Containers should be kept dry and sealed. Containers which are opened must be carefully resealed and kept upright to prevent leakage.

Keep away from oxidizing agents, from strongly alkaline and strongly acid materials.

Always keep in containers of same material as the original one. See also instructions on the label. Avoid heating and direct sunlight.

Additional information about engineering measures

Provide adequate ventilation. Where reasonably practicable this should be achieved by the use of local exhaust ventilation and good general extraction. If these are not sufficient to maintain concentrations of vapours or particles below the OEL (=Occupational Exposure Limit), suitable respiratory protection must be worn.

If workplace limits are exceeded, a gas mask approved for this purpose must be worn.

Butylrubber $\geq 0,5\text{mm}$ ≥ 480 min. After washing hands replace lost skin fat by fat containing skin creams. By using other gloves with a lower endurance, change them more often.

10. Stability and reactivity

Conditions to avoid

Stable under recommended storage and handling conditions(See section 7).

Materials to avoid

Keep away from oxidizing agents, strongly alkaline and strongly acid materials in order to avoid exothermic reactions. Exothermic reactions with isocyanates and epoxide resin.

Hazardous decomposition products

Corrosive gases / vapours. Ammonia When exposed to high temperatures may produce hazardous decomposition products such as carbon monoxide and dioxide, smoke, oxides of nitrogen.
